



LANDSCAPE TECHNICIAN, FULL-TIME

The Foundation is seeking a Landscape Technician to work closely with the Manager of Horticulture and Grounds to maintain Maymont's 100 acres of gardens and lawns.

Essential Functions include:

- Landscape maintenance such as but not limited to grass cutting, leaf raking, trimming, brush removal
- Assist with all garden maintenance tasks year-round
- Operate landscaping equipment and tools
- Perform routine maintenance on landscaping equipment and tools
- Lead garden volunteers
- Maintain clean and organized work areas and storage spaces
- Occasional weekend and evening work as needed, including storm clean-up and special event support.
- Assist the larger Park Operations department on an as-needed basis.
- Support the mission and vision of Maymont Foundation by participating in several events throughout the year
- Other duties as assigned

Core Competencies:

- Ability to follow directions and work independently or as part of a team.
- Excellent communication skills
- Should be comfortable with and capable of working in a professional manner with people from diverse backgrounds
- Ability to perform the manual work required: including lifting, carrying and climbing

Education and Experience:

- A minimum of 2 years varied experience in the landscape industry
- GED or equivalent
- Experience with zero-turn mower and two-cycle engine equipment such as weed eater, blower, hedge clippers and chainsaw. Additional experience operating tractors and similar equipment preferred.
- Ability to lift 50 lbs. repeatedly and to perform physical tasks in all weather and temperature conditions
- Valid driver's license required
- Must pass pre-employment DMV and background checks
